SEA AND FRESHWATER FISHING LEAGUES 2016 - 2017

This year the fishing committee have decided to try a new league format which was suggested by members and passed at the fishing committee for the leagues, with enjoyable participation and Conservation the main priorities.

This year the League will be one Senior Singles League only, one Junior Singles League Sea and Freshwater and the Senior Freshwater League.

It is hoped that this will create greater involvement and competition amongst fellow anglers. All leagues will be fished over 12 months from 1st December 2016 to 30th November 2017.

All Leagues to be fished to PSAA Rules and Weights.

Entry fees can be paid to any current fishing committee member in which they will produce you with a receipt. If no committee member is available please leave fees behind the bar with Bar Staff along with your name & time paid.

All weigh in slips must be filled out correctly and placed on the clipboard(upstairs in the main bar area) **IMMEDIATELY** after the fish has been weighed and witnessed. If weigh in forms are not filled out correctly then your fish will be disqualified All fish must be disposed of properly or your fish will be disqualified.

RULES to Junior Sea and Freshwater League:

- 1. NO Fish under 25% of PSAA specimen rating will be accepted for the League.
- 2. Maximum of 12 fish over a 12 month period, with a maximum of three of a specie sea or freshwater.
- 3. £3 entry Fee per junior MUST be paid 24 Hours before you can weigh in a league fish.
- 5. You may enter this league at any stage throughout the year.
- 6. The Prize money for the League will be determined by the total amount of entry fees.
- 7.1st Prize 60 per cent, 2nd Prize 40 per cent.
- 8. Final fish MUST be weighed in by 10.30pm on the last day 30th November.
- 9. Catch and release fish allowed can be entered for League from shore only.

Rules to Singles League:

- 1.Maximum of 12 fish over a 12 month period starting 1st December and finishing on 30th November. NO Fish under 50% of PSAA specimen rating will be accepted for the League.
- 2.£8 entry Fee per person MUST be paid 24 Hours before you can weigh in a league fish.
- 3. You may enter the Singles league at any stage throughout the year.
- 4. Maximum of two fish of each species from boat and maximum of three fish of each species from shore.
- 5.No upgrading of fish.
- 6. Juniors can fish the Singles league but have to fish to Singles league rules and pay Single league prices.
- 7. The Prize money for the Singles league will be determined by the total amount of entry fees.
- 8.1st Prize 60 per cent, 2nd Prize 40 per cent.
- 9. There will be 3 prizes of £25 each awarded for anglers who weigh-in all 12 fish over 50% of specimen weights in their League, excluding the anglers who win 1^{st} and 2^{nd} places.
- 10. Catch and release fish allowed can be entered for League from shore only.
